TECHNICAL DETAILS

The Estate

The Schloss Mühlenhof property is a large estate (nearly 20ha) spread across the slopes above Kettenheim, 3km south of Alzey. This size would seem reasonable, if not expected, considering the estate was started in 1846 and is now hosting the 6th generation. In 2019 they decided to expand their range and experiment with a low intervention approach that lead to their 'Boden Funk' wines. 'Boden Funk' can be roughly translated as 'sound waves' and is meant to express that the terroir is being transmitted through the roots, into the vines and then finally the grapes.

Wine Making

From 18 year old vines planted to 1.2 hectares of calcareous clay soils and harvested at the end of September. Pressed immediately followed by fermentation lasting eight weeks under temperature control. Aged for seven months in stainless steel before bottling. Unfiltered.

Food Suggestions

Pairs well with shellfish, vegetarian dishes, lean fish, and mushrooms.

TASTING NOTES

Very fun sauvignon blanc, mineral, green apples, lemon and dry citric. The palate greets you to grapefruit, lemon — delightfully light and fruity.

Pinot Noir grape blend.
