The Estate

To create a beautifully balanced and complete wine, the 2018 Postmark Cabernet Sauvignon comes from both hillside and valley floor vineyards in some of Napa Valley's most famed sub appellations, including St. Helena, Atlas Peak, Rutherford, Mt. Veeder, Diamond Mountain and Stag's Leap.

Wine Making

While a warm, dry winter and a wet spring led to a later-than-normal start to the 2018 growing season, picture-perfect summer weather in Napa Valley ensured ideal ripeness in the grapes, yielding Cabernet Sauvignon with lovely color, silky tannins and vibrant fruit flavors. Aged for 12 months in 100% French oak and 40% in new oak.

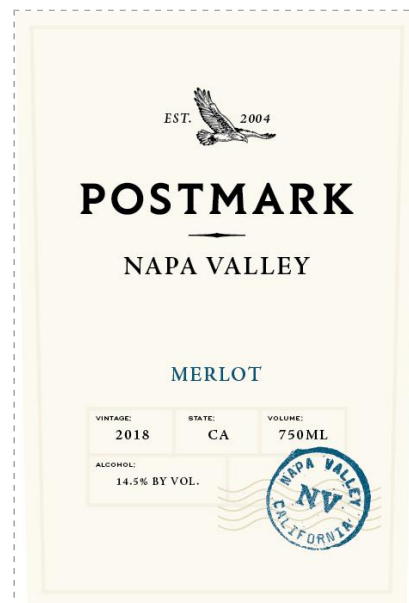
From its deep crimson color to its velvety texture and alluring layers of fresh blackberry, boysenberry and cassis, you can taste the warm Napa Valley sun in this luxurious Cabernet. On the palate, hints of violet, lavender and dark chocolate add to the delicious depth of this wine, with a pleasing touch of acidity bringing brightness and poise to a lush fruit-driven finish.
