TECHNICAL DETAILS

The Estate

Established by Antonio Garofoli in 1871, the Garofoli estate is the oldest wine company in the Marche, Italy. His son Gioacchino continued his father's work and founded Gioacchino Garofoli in 1901. He was succeeded by his sons, Dante and Franco, and they were both succeeded by Franco's sons, Carlo and Gianfranco

Wine Making

Macrina was one of the first Verdicchio wines bottled in a Bordeaux-style bottle, signaling a new style of Verdicchio more modern than the wines formerly produced in amphora-shaped bottles. The wine uses slightly late-harvested grapes to give it more body and longevity. The name Macrina comes from Saint Macrina, whose likeness was in a votive shrine near the vineyard where people from the farms used to pray.

Food Suggestions

Pairs well with fried or grilled fishes and spicy white meat.

TASTING NOTES

Brisk, bright and energetic with fresh and floral notes in a dry style. There is a subtle salinity to this wine that seems to remind one as to just how close the vineyards are to the Adriatic Sea – plus it helps make the wine irresistible. Unoaked and easy drinking.

100% Verdicchio grape blend.
