Emilie Gervoson and her two sisters are leading Chateau Larrivet Haut- Brion into the future with some frsh ideas and experimentation at this historic Chateau. Spiced cherry, blackcurrant, dried oyster, black olive and bark on the nose. It's medium-to full-bodied with firm, creamy tannins. Chewy and flavorful with a savory, mineral finish. Better from 2023.

This has developed into a gorgeous wine. There is plenty of the tannin I saw in barrel tastings, and yet the elements are so well balanced today. Iron, cedar, dried herbs, licorice, dried flowers and mint add striking savory undertones to this deceptively mid weight Pessac Leognan. Larrivet Haut-Brion is one of the most distinctive reds of the vintage. 93- Vinous
