### **TECHNICAL DETAILS**

#### The Estate

100% Hillside Vineyards.

Steep hillside vineyards present the ultimate challenge. Mountainous terrain tests both the grower and the vine.

But the results can be extraordinary.

Hillside vineyards have less access to water, with the rockier soil also holding fewer nutrients. These conditions stress the vines, resulting in the production of a fraction of the fruit of most vineyards. The harsh environment causes the vines to struggle, yielding fewer clusters and smaller berry size. Since most of the flavor resides in the grape skins, the result is berries that are loaded with rich, ripe, intensely concentrated flavors and complexity.

Hillside vineyards are special. So is the wine that is crafted from them.

#### Wine Making

Aging this wine for an average of 12 months in a combination of new and used French oak barrels imparts hints of vanilla, waffle cone and toasty oak.

### Food Suggestions

Pairs well with beef, veal, deer, venison, and poultry dishes.

# **TASTING NOTES**

Cool breezes and damp fog build character in this Russian River Valley Pinot Noir. French oak complements bold red fruit and floral aromatics with a veil of vanilla, waffle cone and toasty oak. Both graceful and vigorous, this wine opens with a perfume of white flowers followed by persistent flavors of red cherry and berries.

100% Pinot Noir grape blend. This wine contains allergens, sulfites.
