TASTING NOTES


The nose offers an explosion of dark mountain fruit with decadent aromas of raspberry-filled chocolates, black currant, mulberry, and huckleberry jam, as well as more savory notes of cedar and spice. On the palate, firm mountain tannins underscore this wine's opulence and age ability, framing the blackberry, fig, and black currant flavors, with bright underlying acidity providing poise and finesse to the long, layered finish.

A grape blend of 90% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Merlot. <u>This wine</u> contains allergens, sulfites.
