TECHNICAL DETAILS

The Estate

Château Chasse-Spleen is the leading Moulis estate along with Château Poujeaux. Although it is classified only as a Cru Bourgeois, it regularly outperforms many of the Médoc's more renowned classed growths.

Wine Making

Vinified in a combination of stainless steel tanks and wooden vats. Malolactic fermentation takes place in vat. Aged in French oak barrels (40% new) for 12-15 months before bottling.

Food Suggestions

Pairs well with beef, lamb, veal, deer, and poultry dishes.

TASTING NOTES

Fresh and very lively black cherry and boysenberry aromas mixed with cedar and pine needles. The palate is medium-bodied with a fine bead of acidity, lovely fleshy blackberry and raspberry fruit mixed with black pepper and tobacco towards the finish.

73% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, & 7% Petit Verdot grape blend.
