Wine Making

This wine is both spontaneous and light, adopting a direct approach without caring about embellishments. Frank and direct by nature, Marie is above all a refreshing wine to be shared without any frills, nothing can beat this wine for a better partner of simple and authentic dishes with its verve and easy-going charms.

Food Suggestions

Pairs well with pork, rich fish such as salmon or tuna, shellfish, vegetarian dishes, poultry dishes, or lean fish.

TASTING NOTES

The color is clear with green hints underlining its characteristic freshness. The nose is delicate and appealing. The bouquet is subtly fruit and floral with notes of citrus fruits, white flowers, and freshly-cut grass. The palate is approachable and delicate, framed around vivid acidity. This wine is both spontaneous and light, adopting a direct approach without caring about embellishments.
