## TECHNICAL DETAILS

### The Estate

Sidónio de Sousa, recognized for having amongst the oldest of the Baga vines in Bairrada, continues to make wine in the traditional way – using 100 year-old Portuguese oak barriques.

### Wine Making

Crushing with partial destemming and cooling the grapes in small open vats, where maceration begins followed by fermentation, without the addition of enzymes or yeast.

### Food Suggestions

Pairs well with beef, lamb, deer, and venison based dishes.

## TASTING NOTES

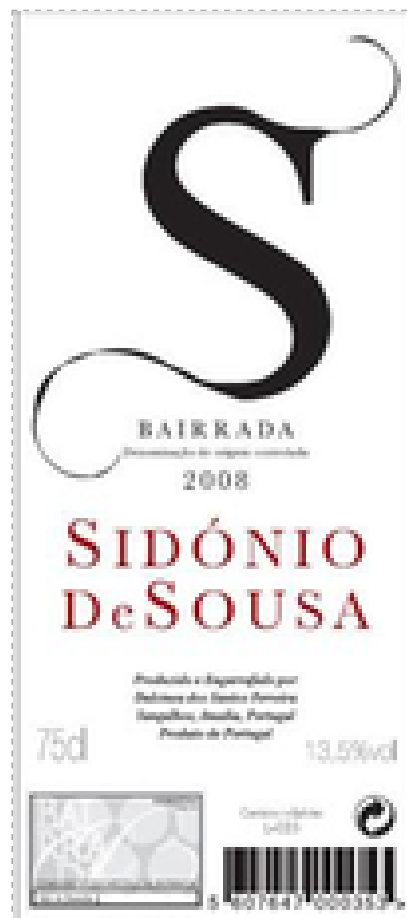
Ripe aromatics of ripe dark fruit are followed by hints of green pepper and raisin. The full-bodied palate is complete with grippy tannins, earthy spice and notes of tar. The finish is smooth, earthy and ripe.
