The Estate

Pujanza Winery is Laguardia enclave in the heart of Rioja Alavesa, one of the most beautiful villages that crown the Spanish, both for its rich culture and history as the people who inhabit and work their land. Opened in June 2002, is one of the youngest wineries launched in the Rioja. Is a family winery heir to a long tradition of San Pedro dynasty in grape growing and winemaking in the capital of Rioja Alavesa.

Wine Making

Spontaneous fermentation and 12 months of ageing in 500 L. French oak barrels and concrete vat. Fermented in 225 and 500-litre French oak barrels, with cask ageing continuing in the same barrels for a period of 12 months.

Food Suggestions

Pairs well with semi-cured cheeses and white meats.

TASTING NOTES

This amazing white wine pours to a pale yellow in color, the appearance of Añadas Frias is clear and bright. The nose offers an intense, serious aroma, with good freshness and concentration, revealing great potential to develop more nuances and complexity with time. In the mouth it has vibrant acidity and an electric sensation, accompanied by very fine tannins and a dry, serious finish.
