The Estate

Within the Spanish wine scene, Mauro produces modern wines with roots, attached to tradition and with signs of their own identity that make them recognizable. Since 1978, Bodegas Mauro has been characterized for producing quality red wines with a vocation for aging and limited production.

Wine Making

The gradual transition to summer temperatures led to a slow and tranquil aromatic ripening of the berries until the harvest, which took place on September 16 without any meteorological surprises.

Food Suggestions

Pairs well as an apertif, with cured cheeses, red meat, and game.

TASTING NOTES

This deep-ruby-colored wine has a bouquet of black cherry, black olive paste and thyme. It is smooth on the palate, with plush tannins and flavors of black cherry, blackberry, clove, dark chocolate and dried mountainside herbs that culminate in a soft, spicy finish.
