The Estate

Since its foundation in 1114 Klosterneuburg Monastery has been growing wine and therefore is the oldest wine estate of Austria. With 108 Hectares of vineyards, it is one of the country's largest and most renowned estates.

Wine Making

The vineyards are situated in selected top locations in Klosterneuburg, Vienna, Gumpoldskirchen and Tattendorf. Since the year 2009 it is the first carbon-neutral wine estate in Europe.

TASTING NOTES

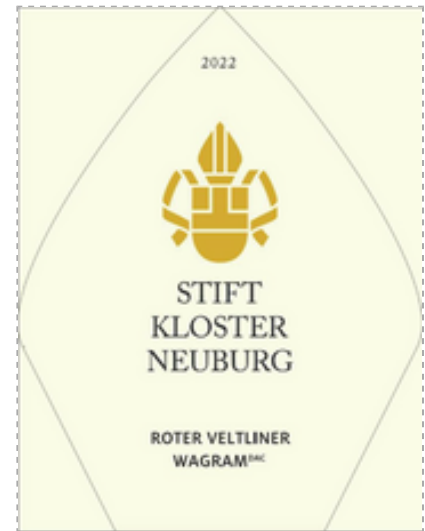
Nose of green apple with grapefruit. A hint of spice with typical pepper and plenty of fruit on the palate. Juicy with elegant acidity.
