TASTING NOTES

Visually, it stands out for its lively ruby red color with violet reflections that testify to its youth. On the nose, it offers a complex bouquet of ripe red fruits such as cherries and blackberries, enriched by spicy nuances and a subtle floral touch. These olfactory notes anticipate a rich and enveloping palate, where balsamic notes and delicate aromatic herbs emerge. On the palate, Monica Genis is soft and well-structured, with delicate tannins that lead to a persistent and aromatic finish.
