Via Morandé was founded in 1996 with the aim of producing innovative wines of great quality, with a clear focus on the development of its brands. We have always prided ourselves on providing an excellent service and commitment to our customers, consumers and the environment.

Wine Making

The Morandé Colección Privada Reserva Malbec from the Maule Valley is made from grapes from old vines, hand-harvested, and undergoes a low-temperature maceration before a Bordeaux-style fermentation. The winemaking process includes a long maceration period, malolactic fermentation in French foudres, and is completed with aging in used French oak barrels for a short period.

Food Suggestions

Pairs well with rich, savory dishes like grilled steaks, lamb chops, and burgers, as well as slow-cooked meats and roasted vegetables.

TASTING NOTES

Morandé Estate Reserve Merlot has fresh red fruit aromas of raspberries and cherries, with notes of white pepper and cedar. On the palate, the cool climate is perceptible in its fruit with its tense acidity and great juiciness. Medium-bodied, with elegant tannins and great freshness.
